Grades K-2

Grades 3-5

Week 1: Write about a tradition your family celebrates and why it's important to you.

Week 2: If you could ask Our Lady of Guadalupe one question, what would it be?

Week 3: Write about someone from Hispanic Heritage Month who made a difference. What would you say to thank them?

Week 4: What is a goal or dream you have? How can God help you reach it?

Grades 6-8

Week 1: Describe a moment when your culture made you feel proud. How did it shape who you are?

Week 2: What's one God-given talent you have? How can you use it to help others?

Week 3: Which saint or Hispanic/Latino leader we learned about inspires you most? Why?

Week 4: In what ways can you help your school be a more welcoming place for all?

Grades 9-12

Week 1: Reflect on a family story, tradition or cultural practice that has helped shape your faith or worldview.

Week 2: What dreams do you believe God has placed in your heart? How can you live them out with integrity?

Week 3: Reflect on this quote: "I am totally at God's disposal." —Blessed José Sánchez del Río. What does it mean to surrender to God's call?
